Scene 1

The tower. Rapunzel sits, alone, playing a board game with herself.

Rapunzel: Ha! I own Park Place! Pay up, sucker! (she moves to the other side of the board) Oh man! Why is it that whenever I have Park Place you never land on it, and when ever you have it, I land there every time? (she goes back to the first side) 'Cause I'm a winner, and you're a loser. Pay up! (to the other side) Why do you have to be such a jerk about it? Why can't you ever be a gracious winner? I don't want to play anymore. (To the other side) You don't want to play? I don't want to play! (She knocks over the game and stomps off in a huff. Then she turns, looks at the board, and sighs.) I really need to find some way of meeting new people.

Suddenly, the room is full of Ninjas.

Rapunzel: New people, I said. Not ninjas.

Ninja: Rapunzel, our Ninja radar tells us that you are unhappy.

Ninja: We've come to amuse you.

Ninja: I brought you some puppets.

Ninja: And I brought some books.

Rapunzel: I have puppets. And I have books. What I really need is a real, actual human to interact with. Preferably not inside this tower.

Ninja: You know you can never leave this tower, Rapunzel.

Rapunzel: Why?

Scene 2

Prince: Rapunzel, Rapunzel, let down your hair!

Rapunzel: What was that?

Prince: Rapunzel, Rapunzel, let down your hair!

Rapunzel goes to the window.

Rapunzel: Is someone out there?

Prince: Rapunzel, Rapunzel, let down your hair!

Rapunzel: I can't even see you, it's too dark!

Prince: Would you let down your hair, already!

Rapunzel: It is down.

Prince: I can't find it.

Rapunzel: Well, of course not! You're way down there and I'm way up here!

Prince: Haven't you got really long hair? Hair so long that it reaches the ground?

Rapunzel: Reaches the ground? Are you kidding? Do you know how much time I'd have to spend brushing my hair every day?

Prince: Well, how am I supposed to get in?

Rapunzel: Why should I let you in?
